

RESOLUTION # 2020- 19

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF HALFMOON,
CENTRE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA (hereinafter the "Municipality")
ADOPTING AN ACT 537 SEWAGE FACILITIES PLAN UPDATE

WHEREAS, Section 5 of the Act of January 24, 1996, P.L. 1535, No. 537, known as the Pennsylvania Sewage Facilities Act, as amended, and the Rules and Regulations of the Department of Environmental Protection adopted thereunder, Chapter 71 of Title 25 of the Pennsylvania Code, requires the Municipality to adopt an Official Sewage Facilities Plan providing for sewage services adequate to prevent contamination of waters and/or environmental health hazards with sewage wastes, and to revise said plan whenever it is necessary to meet the sewage disposal needs of the Municipality, and

WHEREAS, The University Area Joint Authority has prepared an Act 537 Sewage Facilities Plan Update to amend the Centre Region Sewage Facilities Plan to upgrade and increase the capacity of the Scott Road Pump Station and Bristol Interceptor, and

WHEREAS, The Act 537 Sewage Facilities Plan Update:

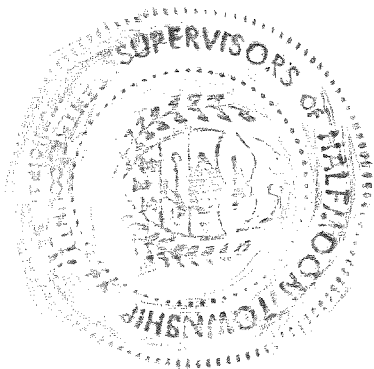
- Identifies the inflow and infiltration issues associated with the Scott Road Pump Station and Bristol Interceptor,
- Evaluates multiple alternative options for correcting the infiltration and inflow issues,
- Describes the selected option (upgrading the pump station and forcemain), and
- Is consistent with the adopted Centre Region Comprehensive Plan.

WHEREAS, the Township of Halfmoon finds that the Act 537 Sewage Facilities Plan Update ordinances and plans and to a comprehensive program of pollution control and water quality management.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Halfmoon Township Board of Supervisors does hereby adopt and submit to the Department of Environmental Protection for its approval as a revision to the Official Plan of the Municipality, the above referenced Act 537 Sewage Facilities Plan Update.
