

RESOLUTION NUMBER 2026-14

A RESOLUTION OF HALFMOON TOWNSHIP, CENTRE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA (hereinafter the "Municipality") ADOPTING AN ACT 537 SEWAGE FACILITIES PLAN UPDATE

WHEREAS, Section 5 of the Act of January 24, 1996, P.L. 1535, No. 537, known as the Pennsylvania Sewage Facilities Act, as amended, and the Rules and Regulations of the Department of Environmental Protection adopted thereunder, Chapter 71 of Title 25 of the Pennsylvania Code, requires the Municipality to adopt an Official Sewage Facilities Plan providing for sewage services adequate to prevent contamination of waters and/or environmental health hazards with sewage wastes, and to revise said plan whenever it is necessary to meet the sewage disposal needs of the Municipality, and

WHEREAS, The University Area Joint Authority has prepared an Act 537 Sewage Facilities Plan Update to amend the Centre Region Sewage Facilities Plan to evaluate several alternatives to improve the reliability and efficiency of the wastewater conveyance system for the western portion of Patton Township within the existing sewer service area.

WHEREAS, The Act 537 Sewage Facilities Plan Update:

- Identifies the current and projected wastewater flows associated with the Marywood, Graysdale 2A, and Graysdale 2B Pump Stations;
- Evaluates the following alternative options:
 - Cedar Cliff Alternative
 - Meeks Lane Alternative A
 - Meeks Lane Alternative B
 - Meeks Lane Alternative C
 - Meeks Lane Alternative D
 - Blueberry Crossing Alternative
 - No Action Alternative
- Describes the selected option, which is Meeks Lane Alternative D that offers the lowest project cost and eliminates three existing pump stations.
- Describes that the Meeks Lane Alternative D which will construct a new pump station along Meeks Lane near Echo Hollow Lane and connect to existing infrastructure. The project consists solely of wastewater conveyance improvements and does not involve new or increased discharge.
- Is consistent with the adopted Centre Region Comprehensive Plan.

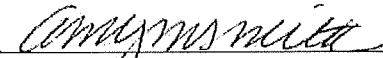
WHEREAS, the Township of Halfmoon finds that the Act 537 Sewage Facilities Plan Update described above conforms to applicable zoning, subdivision, other municipal ordinances and plans and to a comprehensive program of pollution control and water quality management.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Halfmoon Township Board of Supervisors does hereby adopt and submit to the Department of Environmental Protection for its approval as a revision to the Official Plan of the Municipality, the above referenced Act 537 Sewage Facilities Plan Update.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Municipality commits to implement the selected alternative within the timeframe established in the implementation schedule contained in the Act 537 Sewage Facilities Plan Update.

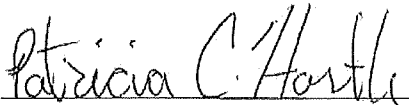
